Following the scanning and automated docking is a unique first in Australia, new precision end matching of zero tolerance squaring accuracy which means the laying of AST floors becomes faster with all joins easily fitting into place resulting in an almost seamless appearance said Darren Dowling.

Whilst the new flooring line is all about engineering, technology and efficiency it also plays a key role in the company's strong commitment to the environment by significantly reducing waste and facilitating the introduction of a new product called Panache.

Panache is an Australian Solar Timbers recycling initiative that reclaims boards and converts them into precisely machined, high quality flooring with a heritage style appearance.

Key operational staff went to Europe and North America for training prior to installation with full training of all AST production team members being given by international specialists both during and after installation.



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
